

## **CAR PARKING IN UXBRIDGE**

### **General advice:**

**Travel by public transport if at all possible**

### **Public Transport**

Uxbridge is on the Metropolitan and Piccadilly lines.

Check [ww.tfl.gov.uk](http://ww.tfl.gov.uk) (Google 'tfl') for information about closures and engineering work.

Uxbridge is amply served by buses terminating at the Bus Station just behind the Tube station.

### **Saturday Afternoons**

**General advice:** the only sure-fire choice is to use one of the paying car parks

**On-street car parking in the centre** is limited to 2 hours and is usually full.

**On street parking in surrounding streets** is subject to residential parking restrictions – see the local signs

**Free car parks** – there are none

Pay and Display car Parks:

- Cedars multi-storey (Shopping centre)

- Granges multi-storey (Shopping centre)

- Civic Centre multi-storey (Saturdays only)

Pay on Exit car parks

- The Chimes (Chippendale Way)

### **Saturday Evenings**

**General advice:** Use The Chimes Pay on Exit car park, currently £1 for the evening.

**On-street car parking in the centre** is free after 6:30 pm but fills up rapidly

**On street parking in surrounding streets** is usually full

### **Paying car parks**

The only paying car park open after 8 pm is The Chimes

Pedestrian entry after the Chimes Shopping Centre closes at 7 pm is opposite the Civic centre in the High Street, up the escalator and through the Cinema foyer.
